Recreational Trail and Land & Water Conservation Fund Grants Available

Applications have become available from the Department for Local Government for the federal grant opportunity of the Recreational Trail Program.

The Recreational Trail Program (RTP) assists for acquisition of easements, development and/or maintenance of recreational trails and trailhead facilities for both motorized and non-motorized use but will not, however, fund equipment such as gators, mowers or trucks. All trails that receive Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) funding must remain open to the public and maintained for perpetuity. The minimum grant request for RTP is \$5,000 and the maximum request is \$100,000. This is a reimbursement grant program with a 80/20 match requirement. The application will close April 30, 2018.
